Agenda item: June meeting minutes

June meeting minutes approved with no edits or amendments by Alyssa Murray.

Agenda item: President Report

Amanda Anderson presented the 24/25 report; the most successful auction to date, we bought lots of stuff for the school (Amanda intends to put this in a written report soon). Motion to approve by Gabi Kolk, seconded by Amy Vander Heyden.

Agenda item: Treasurer Report

Home and School Association treasurer Leslie Martin gave the treasurer report. Josh added that the school board ended up providing money for ukulele's, so instead of the money we put towards them, they will buy other instruments for the music room. Motion to approve report by Amy Vander Heyden and seconded by Amanda Anderson. See attached financial recap from last years expenses.

Agenda item: New business

A. Discuss moving the auction to 3 years away and vote on proposed budget:

We discussed the possibility of moving the next auction to 3 yrs instead of 2 in order to continue offsetting the Dorothy Daglish auction years. With the currently budgeted items being spent we will still have approx \$46 000 left over for additional expenditures. We re-read the last auction letter to ensure it was all encompassing to be able to make it 3 years. Josh also mentioned an email he got to make sure we follow all of the fundraising rules for the school board, we reviewed and do follow them. Motion to approve current budget and move the auction to 3 years by Chelsea Vander Heyden, seconded by Leslie Martin, all approved. Alyssa Murray also made a motion to pay for hot lunch for the year, and we can revisit it again next year, all approved. There will be \$9000 budgeted for hot lunch for the year.

B. Present and vote on new by-laws:

Alyssa and Gabi presented amendments to the current bylaws. Discussion was had on some wording. They will have the bylaws finished and ready to send off by the next meeting. Josh will confirm with the Holy Spirit School Division that we may adjust the bylaws without additional approval from the division. All voted to approve the bylaws as presented. *Amended on Sept. 15th – Josh confirmed via email that we do not need further approval from the school division to adjust our bylaws*.

Agenda item: Election of positions

Gabi began by reviewing the positions terms according to the bylaws. Secretary is only a 1 year term and the other positions are 2-year terms. She continued by requesting nominations, if anyone is interested in a particular position or would like their name to stand. Both president and vice-president have one year remaining and therefore will let their names stand. Secretary and Treasurer are up and both Leslie and Michelle would like to be replaced. Michelle stated she would only like to hold one position – either hot lunch coordinator or secretary. Chelsea Vander Heyden offered to fill the secretary role, and no one wanted to solely fill the hot lunch coordinator. All voted in favor of Chelsea Vander Heyden filling the secretary role. Michelle will pass her secretary binder and email a meeting minute/agenda template to Chelsea. No one present would like to fill the Treasurer role. Gabi suggested they do some searching to find someone and Leslie will remain in the position until someone is found.

Regarding divisions 1, 2, and 3 representatives Gabi asked what these positions job description was. Other than putting together auction baskets for classes, no one really understood what was required. Gabi suggested we eliminate these positions. It was also suggested that we could coordinate with School Council – as they are requesting one or two parent representatives per class this year, and have those individuals come to us for any requests/needs. Everyone voted in favor of eliminating the 3 representative division positions and contacting

the School Council. It was also suggested we try to coordinate our meetings with the School Council to be back-to-back to allow more individuals to attend both. This request will be passed onto the School Council.

• Hot lunch coordinator – Michelle Rodgers

Agenda item: School Requests & Reports

Associate Principal Josh Gatner attended and spoke on behalf of St Catherine School. He had no specific requests but provided an update that Dan is still working on having the concrete tables replaced. Grade 9 camping trip is in a couple weeks and most of the students are attending this year, which is great. Josh provided all Home and School association members access to his 2025-2026 SGF Home and School summary budget document.
