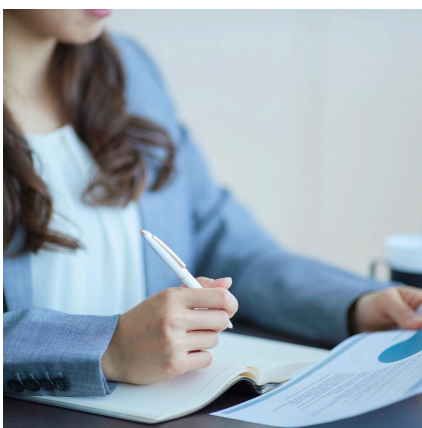

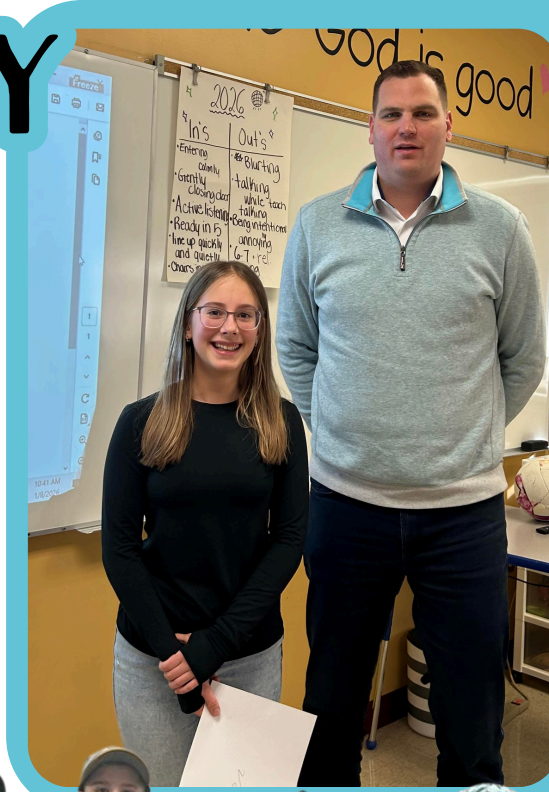
- Survey takes 5-15 minutes

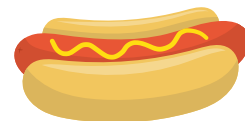
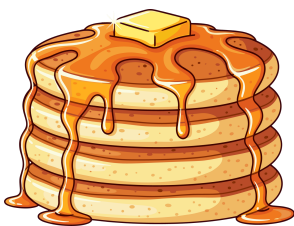

Ash wednesday



Ash Wednesday: Begins the Lenten season, it's a day of fasting/abstaining from meat to bring our bodies into a deeper awareness of sacrifice and unite ourselves closer to Christ.

Why ashes? The wearing of ashes is a common penitential practice throughout the Old Testament. Penitential practices can do great good for our souls, helping us keep in mind our death and the brevity of the world, while holding onto the hope and joy of our eternity in heaven. When we think of our death, it can help us think of our life, how we live, where we want to be, where we want to go and hopefully our desire for heaven.

How are you living? What are you focusing on?

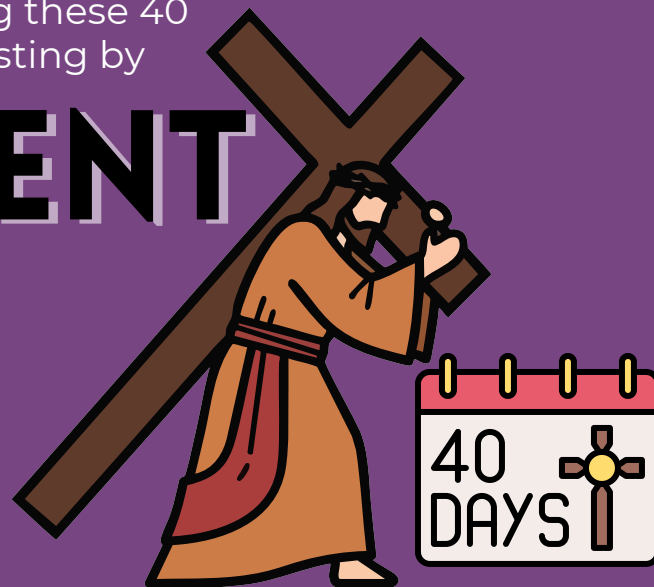
Lent is the liturgical time before Easter when Catholics prepare to celebrate Jesus's Resurrection. During these 40 days we focus on bettering ourselves through fasting by building new healthy habits for our body, spirit, and mind. In fasting we remind ourselves that we are made for heaven, and although suffering is part of life, God redeems us and invites us to focus on Him, and our future with him in heaven.

Our fasts should be challenging, but not impossible. Its not just removing things but to take on a new healthy habit to replace the bad or not as good.

IDEAS:

If you give up social media, or streaming shows, you should try to fill that time with a new virtuous practice like reading scripture, praying the rosary, maybe watching the Chosen tv series instead. Going to adoration or confession more regularly is always a great practice. You could also switch up your music or podcasts with Christian artists, or religious podcasts like "Abiding together", Rosary or Bible in a year.
