Volunteers are still needed to help bring more experiences to this day







### Lent: March 5 - April 17

The Lenten season has begun. Lent spans 40 days and goes from Ash Wednesday to Holy Thursday. These 40 days we are called to fast and pray, like Jesus did for 40 days in the desert when He was preparing himself for His mission. Lent offers us the same opportunity, to intentionally sacrifice, and offer things up through prayer and fasting. This helps us prioritize our relationship with God in new ways. Use these 40 days to refocus; spend more time in prayer, form life giving habits, and take your spiritual life seriously.

- 5. Place your child's lunch order(s) on your school's ordering calendar by clicking the blue date for the scheduled vendors.

The following credit cards are accepted: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Debit MasterCard, or Visa Debit. Visa and MasterCard prepaid cards are also accepted.
