Log in/register for your School Cash Online account to get ready for the upcoming school year.

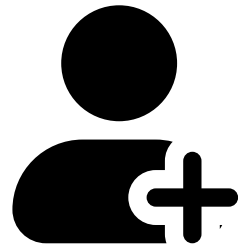
### How to register

Go to <https://holyspirit.schoolcashionline.com> and click  **Register.**

- Enter your first name, last name, email address, and create a password you won't forget, or write it where it won't be lost.
- Select a security question
- Select Yes to receive email notifications (this is not promotional emails.)
- You will receive a confirmation via email. *Check your Spam folder if you don't receive it.*
- Use your email address and password to log in to your account.

### How to add children to your account

- Sign in to SchoolCash Online:  
<https://holyspirit.schoolcashionline.com>
- At the top of the page, navigate to **My Account**.
- From the dropdown menu, select **My Students**.



Click to add a child.

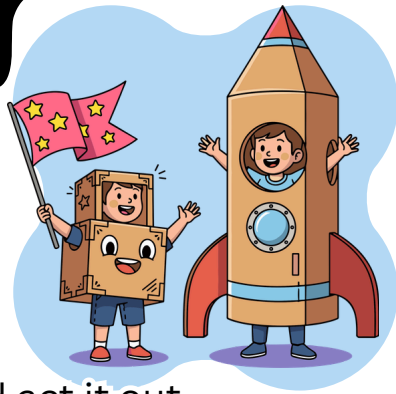
- Type your school board name: **Holy Spirit Catholic School Division**
- Choose your school from the list: **St Catherine School Picture Butte**
- Enter your child's details: All Children starting in Kindergarten get a new student number. Contact the School to ask for their **ASN Alberta Student Number** It's 9 characters long and begins with a "3".
- **Click Confirm.**

# Enjoy summer & KEEP LEARNING. ADVENTURES



- Start a Summer journal, write for 20 minutes every day!
- Everytime you read, use a different room or space.
- After reading a book, pick a scene or even the whole story and act it out.
- Create a comic strip, about something you can only do in the summer.
- Write “a day in the life” story of a pet, or animal you see outside.
- Make an at home museum, with items from around the house and yard.
- Read books that have been made into movies: take a few weeks to read the book slowly and thoughtfully, once finished create an *opening night*, dress up as your favourite character to watch the movie, even make special snacks!
- Make a nature alphabet book, fill it with things you see outside, one for each letter. *IE A:Ant, B: Blade of Grass, L:Leaf, P: Petal*
- Write a letter to your grandparents, and mail it.
- While reading outloud have a friend or family member act it out.
- Make a family story jar – pick a new prompt each day and create a story together.
- Write out the lyrics to your favorite song from memory.
- Spell out words using large objects (e.g. toys, books, branches)
- Draw a family tree and write a sentence or two about each person.
- Invent a new breakfast cereal and write out a script for a commercial, cover an old cereal box and create the brand.

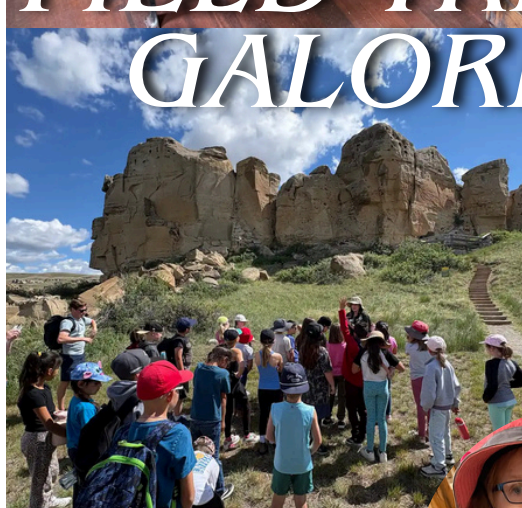

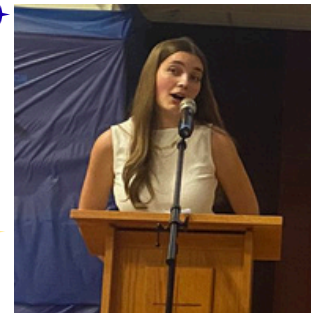

# BUSSING STUDENTS

Reminders and what you need to know

2026-2027 School year remains at 1.6 KM funded distance.

Alberta Education states in the School Act students in Kindergarten and up, living beyond 1.6 kilometres are, by the most direct route from their boundary school, or designated Division programs located in specific schools, funded for transportation.



Any NEW bus kids, or anyone whose MOVED this summer. Please fill out the "**New bussing form.**" from the Website and email it to

[scpboffice@holyspirit.ab.ca](mailto:scpboffice@holyspirit.ab.ca).

You can also come to the office BEFORE the first day of school to help apply. **ASN** Alberta Student Number are needed, it starts with a 3.

*(Kindergarten parents the ASN is a new number, that will be assigned in August and will now be the permanent number used for your kids)*

*Because of this Kindergarteners will be able to apply for busses in AUGUST.*

After the office emails your forms to Palliser, they are the ones who you will contact you, with all bussing information.
