

Jr. High End-of-Year Schedule - June '25



The last two weeks of school will bring new routines and events that may need additional attention from the families of our Junior High school students. In order to make sure parents know what to expect, we wanted to communicate some of the upcoming school events - which include final exams, year-end mass, PATs (Provincial Achievement Tests), and field trips.

All final exams and PATs will be written in the classrooms with students needing to

stay in the room for a minimum of 1 hour. They are expected to bring their own pens, pencils, erasers, and - when necessary - a calculator. As has been our practice, final exams, including Grade 6 and 9 PATs will be factored as 20% of the final subject grades. Please be aware that PATs cannot be written earlier than scheduled in the event that a student is expecting to be absent.

As there are no regular classes after the exams, Grade 7-9 students are free to go home upon the conclusion of their exams on June 19th, and June 23rd through June 25th. However, before we allow students to leave, we ask that parents give permission in advance by calling or emailing the office at scpboffice@holyspirit.ab.ca. If they have permission, then students will need to come to the office to sign out before they depart. In the event that a student needs to stay for the entirety of the day, they will be supervised by a teacher and will have the opportunity for self-directed study and/or to do some physical activity.


OPPORTUNITIES IN JUNE!
